The applicant needs to express their progress and benefit from participating in those programs. The applicant can Invite experts from Asian countries to Cambodia for training, workshop or conference etc. Support 4 Categories: - Transportation - Accommodation - Per-diems - Registration fee and other expenses related to travel.
Art and cultural practitioners from all disciplines (Film, performing arts, visual arts, writing communities. etc.
At least 1 month before your traveling BUT we strongly
encourage you to apply with a long duration of submission if you know the opportunity ahead of time quite long.

Application Form

- The application can be completed in Khmer or English, whichever you feel most comfortable to express yourself in.

As an alternative to completing the application form in writing, you may submit a video or audio recording for some or all of the questions. You must make sure that all points are addressed. Please use the word counts as a guideline for the length of your answers. 100 words should be approximately 1 minute of speaking.

- Your impression about the importance of program/learning progress to add more ideas, experiences, knowledge, and on how to develop the art.
- A commitment to writing a brief narrative report from what you have learned from attending the program

Your applications will be reviewed and selected by an independent committee. The committee will report to the "Mobility Grant" team. The application is expected to hear the result within 7 working days after submission.
