

In October and November the Cambodian Living Arts team will present our 2020 Cultural Season under the theme *Expressing Identities: Them and Us*. Throughout the season we will share a selection of different performances, talks and workshops exploring this theme across different mediums, from contemporary dance to new writing for theatre and new traditional music.

As of October 8th 2020, Cambodia has had 281 reported cases of COVID-19 and no reported deaths. While these numbers are relatively low compared to many countries around the world, we are taking the risk of COVID-19 seriously, and will be implementing the following precautionary measures—as advised by Cambodia's Ministry of Health—to ensure the safety of our artists and our audience members:

- Social distancing: we will limit our theatre to half capacity to ensure audience members are seated at a safe distance from each other, and mark lines for ticketing and restrooms so that our guests can keep a safe distance from each other.
- Hand sanitizer will be available for audiences and our Cultural Season team at the entrance, tech room and artist dressing rooms.
- Masks will be provided for all audience members when they present their tickets.
- Temperature checks will be conducted upon entry, and following guidelines from the Ministry of Health, anyone who displays an abnormal will be requested to leave and given a full refund.
- Regular cleanings of the theater, stage, and artist dressing rooms.
