About Mobility Grant	
What is the Mobility grant?	This grant supports people who attend art and cultural events such as workshops, residency, training courses, and research presentations in Asian Countries. The applicant needs to express their progress and benefit from participating in those programs. The applicant can Invite experts from Asia countries to Cambodia for training, workshop or conference.

	Support 4 Categories: - Transportation - Accommodation - Per-diems - Registration fee and other expenses related to travel.
Who could apply?	Art and cultural practitioners from all disciplines (Film, performing arts, visual arts, writing communities. etc.
Validation of submissions	At least 1 month before your traveling but we strongly encourage you to apply with a long duration of submission if you know the opportunity ahead of time is quite long. In case the application is submitted shorter than one month, the applicant is required to submit justifiable evidence, e.g. letter of explanation from the host. Yet, this still doesn't guarantee the success of the application as it will be decided by the committee.

Application Form

- The application can be completed in Khmer or English, whichever you feel most comfortable to express yourself in.
- As an alternative to completing the application form in writing, you may submit a video or audio recording for some or all of the questions. You must make sure that all points are addressed. Please use the word counts as a guideline for the length of your answers. 100 words should be approximately 1 minute of speaking. - Your Commitments
 - You must show your strong commitment to attending the events
 - Your impression about the importance of program/learning progress to add more ideas, experiences, knowledge, and on how to develop the art.
 - A commitment to writing a brief narrative report from what you have learned from attending the program NO LATER THAN ONE MONTH upon your return
