



## **ETHNO SWEDEN**

### **Call for Scholarship Applications**

Cambodian Living Arts is offering up to 2 full scholarships to attend the traditional music camp Ethno Sweden in 2019. This is taking place in cooperation with Folkmusikens hus (FMH) in Sweden.

#### **What is Ethno?**

Ethno invites young people from different countries and cultures to join together to make music based on traditional music from their culture, in a free and open-minded way. Ethno is for both young musicians of the traditional folk and jazz scenes and for musicians with a classical background who are looking for new and refreshing motivation. Ethno camps involve a unique combination of workshops, jam sessions and performances. Participants get to know a variety of musical styles and to invent new tunes on their own, with the support of the artistic leaders. Ethno means living and learning together in order for oral music traditions to be passed on directly from person to person.

Ethno is a programme of Jeunesses Musicales International (JMI), which aims to create an intercultural understanding that enables exchange between European, Arab, African, Asian and American regions.

For one week, you will share your music with young musicians from all over the world. At Ethno Sweden you will be meeting over 100 people and staying at a local school close to a lake. Expect more than 10 different nationalities to share their music and culture.

### **Scholarship**

There are two scholarships available for Ethno Sweden. The scholarships fully cover the following costs:

- Return flight to Sweden
- Local transport from airport to workshop location
- Visa fees
- Health insurance
- Workshop participation fee
- Food and accommodation

### **Eligibility**

- Cambodian musician or singer with interest in traditional music
- Age: 18-25
- Working knowledge of spoken English
- Very open to learning traditional music from all over the world and performing together
- Confident to teach Cambodian music to a large group of international musicians
- Happy to actively engage in cultural exchange
- Willing to share your new knowledge with peers in Cambodia after your return (for example through workshops and/or as volunteer for Ethno Cambodia)

### **After the Scholarship**

Once you come back from Ethno Sweden, Cambodian Living Arts would like to organize an event with you where you can share the new tunes you have learnt and tell us about your experiences. You are also expected to share your new skills and techniques with your musical peers at a series of small Ethno workshops in Cambodia, or at Ethno Cambodia.
